## What is Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)?

CSA is a program where each member buys a share of a farm's **organic and locally grown vegetables** for a season. The Tierra Direct CSA season starts in the summer and ends in the fall. For 2014, the season begins on **June 5** and ends on **October 30**--that's 22 weeks of fresh vegetables!

## What is included in the vegetable share?

A CSA share from Tierra Direct includes **over 30 vegetable varieties** from La Baraja Farm, located in Goshen, NY (about 56 miles northwest of Washington Heights).

## How does the CSA work?

Sign-ups and payments are due by Wednesday, May 21. Then, every Thursday starting June 5 and ending October 30, **each member will receive 8-10 different vegetables every week**, valued at about \$23. The amount of vegetables provided each week feeds up to four people.

## How much does each share cost?

Each share costs a total of \$523.50. That covers \$23 worth of vegetables for 22 weeks, and also includes a \$5 network fee to our affiliate Just Food plus \$12.50 for administrative costs to run the CSA.

## Can I split a share? Are half shares available?

Yes, you can indicate on the Membership Agreement Form that your share will be split. However, if you wish to split a share, you are responsible for finding a co-member to split the share with. Co-members are responsible for splitting up the share themselves.

## Where do I pick up my share?

Distribution takes place **every Thursday from 5:00pm to 8:00pm** after the 175th Street Farmers Market, located at **175th Street between Broadway and Wadsworth.**

## How do I join the CSA?

Complete the Membership Agreement Form and submit it with your payment by May 21. ## Do you offer payment plans?

Although we prefer that you pay for your entire share at the time that you sign up, **payments can be made in installments of your choice.** However, all payments must be made by Wednesday, May 21 by 7:30pm. Only cash or checks can be accepted. Credit cards can not be accepted.

## What if I can't pick up my share?

If you know you will be out of town or unavailable, we suggest that you arrange to have a family member or friend pick up your share and enjoy the week's bounty. Unfortunately, your share cannot be held, refunded, or replaced.
